Dear Mr. Wilkins:

Reference is made to your submittal of revised Form C-128 covering El Dorado #1 Atlas in Unit J, Section 34-25N-10W.

We note that you have indicated you intend to dedicate the SE $\frac{1}{4}$  NE $\frac{1}{4}$  and the NE $\frac{1}{4}$  SE $\frac{1}{4}$  to this well. This type of acreage dedication is not permitted under the terms of Order R-1069-B. If it is at all possible I would suggest that the NW $\frac{1}{4}$  SE $\frac{1}{4}$  of Section 4 be communitized with the NE $\frac{1}{4}$  S $\frac{1}{4}$  so that a standard unit may be formed.

In the event that this cannot be accomplished it would be necessary that you make application for hearing before the Oil Conservation Commission to consider the establishment of the non-standard unit. This application should be directed to Mr. A. L. Porter, Jr., Secretary and Director of the Commission, Box 871, Santa Fe, New Mexico.

Your #1 Atlas well will of necessity have to be assigned an allowable on the basis of a 40-acre dedication until such time as an 80-acre unit may be formed.

Reference is made to your submission of revised Form O-122 covering  
the proposed lease to Unit 1, Section 34-36-10N.

We note that you have indicated you intend to develop the Unit 1  
and the 2nd 1/4 in this well. This type of surface dedication is not  
permitted under the terms of Order 1-105-1. If it is at all  
possible I would suggest that the Unit 1 and 2nd 1/4 be commuted  
which the Unit 2nd 1/4 as that a standard unit may be formed.

In the event that this cannot be accomplished it would be necessary  
that you make application for hearing before the Oil Commission  
Commissioner to consider the establishment of the non-standard unit.  
This application should be directed to Mr. A. L. Porter, Jr., Secretary  
and Director of the Commission, Box 211, Ardmore, Oklahoma.

One of the well will of necessity have to be assigned an allowable  
on the basis of a 10-acre deduction unit and time as an 80-acre unit  
may be formed.
