- 10-15,16-56 Ran and cemented $4\frac{1}{2}$ " 10.8# drill tubing as casing at 5296' with 200 sacks construction cement. Flanged up. Cleaned out to 5270'. Perforated four $1\frac{1}{2}$ " jets/ft intervals 5112-5130 and 5141-5148.
- 10-17,18-56 Shabbed, recovered 44.2 bbl. mud cut oil.
- 10-19,20-56 Sand-oil fractured formation with 10,000 gal. crude and 1#/gal. sand.
- 10-21 to 11-7-56 Shabbed. Recovered a total of 550 bbl. fluid, 180 bbl. remaining in formation.
- 11-8-56 Sand-oil fractured with 1185 bbl. crude oil and 45,000# sand.

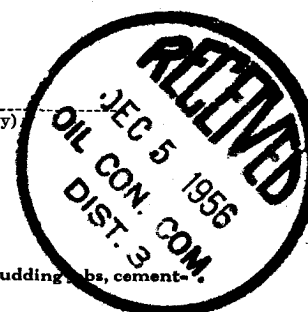
