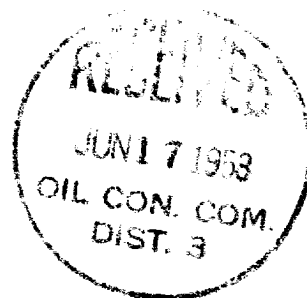

In the process of completing our Fred Francisco No. 1 well located in Section 30, T-25-N, R-10-W, of the Bisti Field, it was necessary to purchase, from some outside source, some oil to displace the mud and water in the casing prior to perforating and fracturing same.

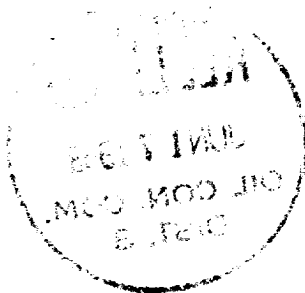

1. *Chlorophyll a* and *Chlorophyll b* were determined by the method of Arar and Collins (1971) using a Shimadzu 1010 spectrophotometer. The concentration of chlorophyll was expressed in $\mu\text{g mL}^{-1}$ of the sample.
