Dear Mr. Nantker:

We have received the corrected survey on your #2 Carson well which by the corrected survey is located 660 feet from the North line and 327.43 feet from the West line of Section 25-25N-12W.

I have talked to Mr. Warren Mankin of our Santa Fe office about this location and he informs me that he has been in communication with you regarding how the matter should best be handled. As you know, by Rule 104, as amended by Order R-855 a wildcat well in this area may be located within 330 feet of a 40-acre boundary. Therefore your location is non-standard by only 2.7 feet. Under the authority granted me by Rule 1303 of the New Mexico Oil Conservation Commission Rules and Regulations I am approving the location as drilled, as I consider that 2.7 feet is certainly a minor deviation from a standard location.
