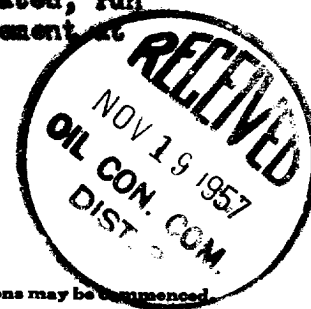

DETAILS OF WORK

We propose to drill this well with rotary tools to a total depth of 5,300' for a Gallup Sand Test.  
Set 8 5/8" O.D. 32# csg. at approximately 275', using sufficient cement to circulate cement to surface.  
Drill 7 7/8" hole to T.D. and if commercial production is indicated, run 5 1/2", 14# J55 sals csg. w/sufficient amount to bring top of cement at least 600' above top of test zone or 600' above csg.  
Perforate production section, test, and frac if necessary.



I understand that this plan of work must receive approval in writing by the Geological Survey before operations may be commenced.

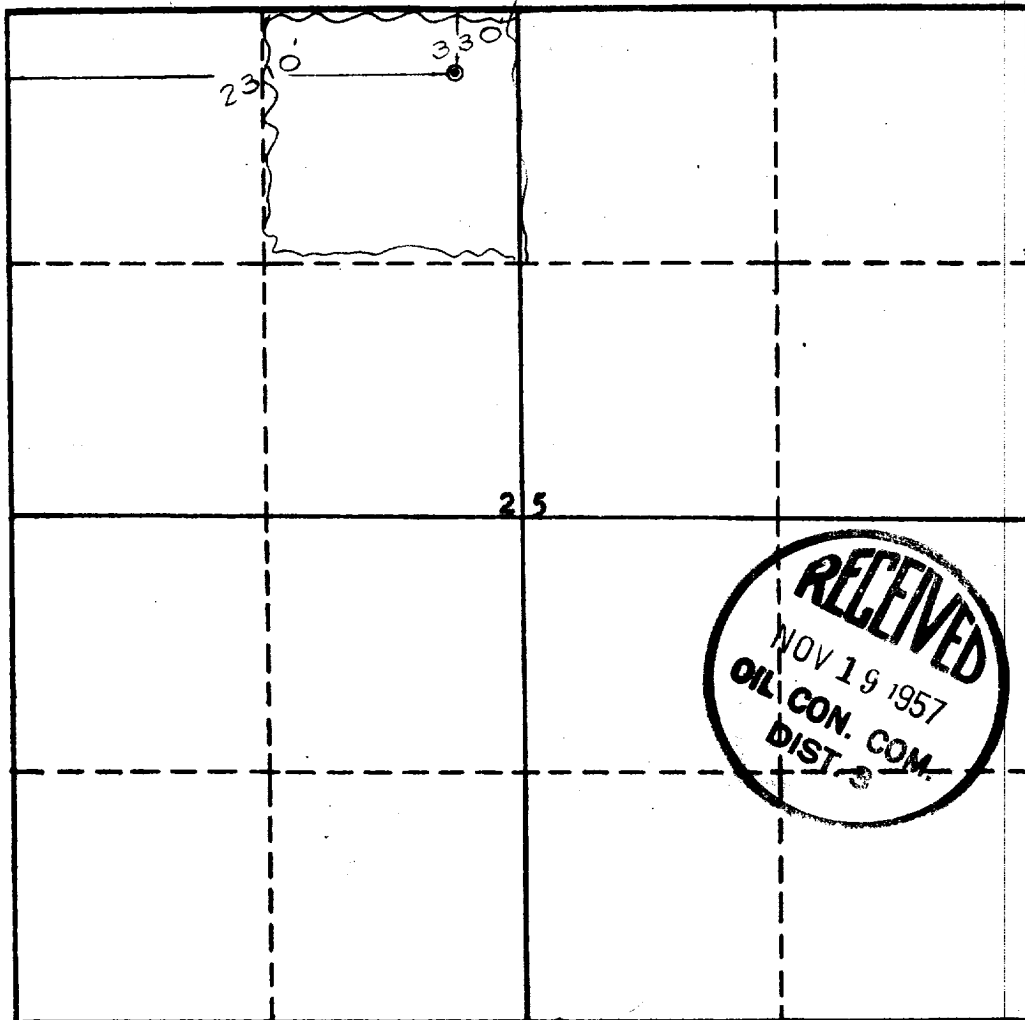
