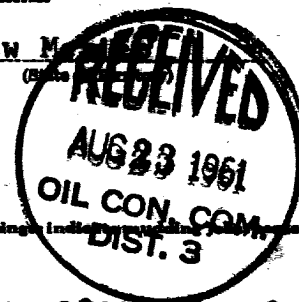

DETAILS OF WORK

Using rotary tools, drilling 12 1/4" surface hole to 180', set 180' of 8-5/8" O. D. 24#, J-55 casing, circulate cement, WOC 18 hrs. and test for water shut-off. Drill 7-7/8" hole to approximately 6530' and if commercial production is indicated, run 4 1/2", 14#, J-55 casing to approximately 6530' and cement with sufficient amount of cement to shut off Gallup formation.



Understand that this plan of work must receive approval in writing by the Geological Survey before operations may be commenced.

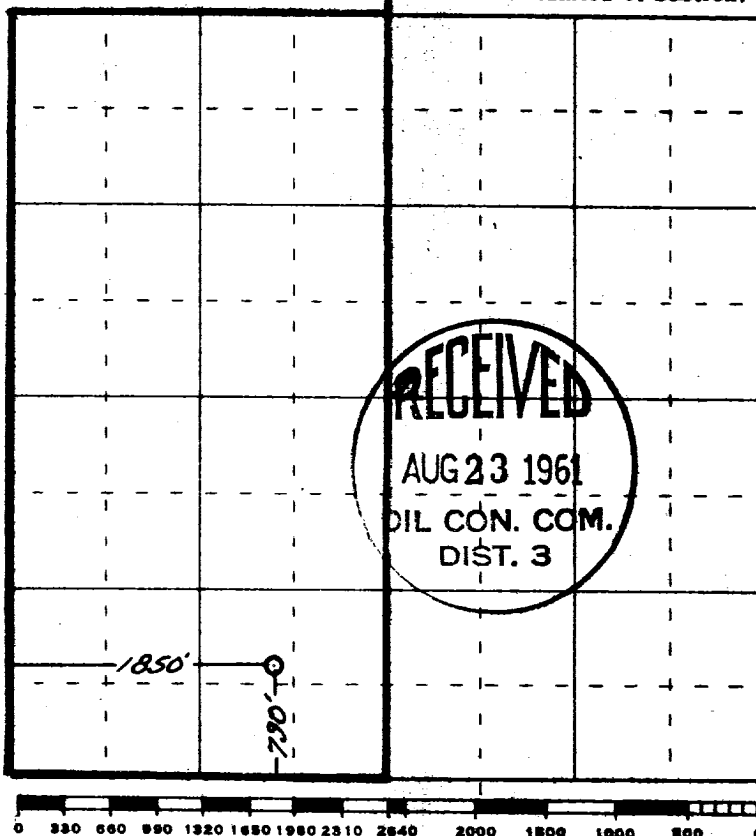
