Gentlemen:

In accordance with the provisions of New Mexico Oil Conservation Rule 504, we are hereby requesting permission to produce, and have run by transporter, 500 barrels of crude oil from our Navajo Allottees "M" Well No. 1. We propose to sand-oil-frac this well and are requesting the 500 barrels clearance to enable us to properly clean up and test well without waste of oil.

Due to the No-Flare Order No. 1427, the above mentioned well is presently shut-in. After the remedial work on this well has been completed, we will again shut well in to comply with the No-Flare Order. When the gas line connection is made on this well and we receive approval to commence reproducing, we will leave the well shut-in until the 500 barrels allowable is made up.
