DETAILS OF WORK

Moved in snub unit, pulled tubing and commenced workover 1-29-60. Treated perforations 4945' to 4947' and 4965' to 4978' with 30,000 gallons of oil containing 30,000 of sand. Rarun tubing and set at 4989'. After snubbing and flowing lead oil, well flowed 120 barrels of 39.8 gravity oil through 1" choke on 24 Nov 60 ending 4:00 P.M., 2-6-60.
