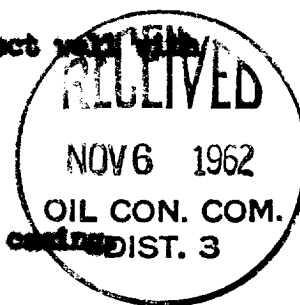

**FULL DETAILS OF PROPOSED PLAN OF WORK**

The **Standard Oil Company of Texas** proposes to plug and abandon subject well with cement plugs as follows:

1. 72 sx cement plug - 4680 to T.D. (4900 feet)
2. 54 sx cement plug - 3560 to 3725 feet.
3. 38 sx cement plug - 1100 to 1200 feet.
4. 16 sx cement plug - 179 to 229 feet. In and out of 8-5/8" casing.
5. 5 sx cement plug - at surface.
6. Install permanent marker.
