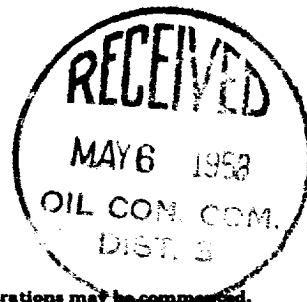
DETAILS OF WORK

After drilling to 214 ft., ran 6 Jts., 10-3/4" 40# J-55 casing (192') - Landed at 206 ft.. Cemented with 150 sacks cement, 2% CC. Plug down 10:45 A.M.

After waiting for cement to set, continued drilling.
