Reference is made to our letter of February 3, 1958, above subject, whereby we submitted to you six copies of Form C-128 covering, among others, The Texas Company's Navajo Allotees "O" well No. 1. Subsequent to our original letter we have determined that this well is actually only a location, the drilling of which is to commence in the near future. Also it was noticed that the proration unit shown for the well was not in accordance with Rule 2 of Order No. R-1069-B. The USGS forms covering a permit to drill this well have been filed and we assume copies of this form will be submitted to you in lieu of Form C-101.

Attached are six copies of a revised Form C-128 which attributes the South one-half of the Southeast quarter of Section 15 to The Texas Company's proposed Navajo Allotees "O" well No. 1. This assignment will conform to the newly adopted rules and regulations for the Bisti Lower Gallup oil pool.
