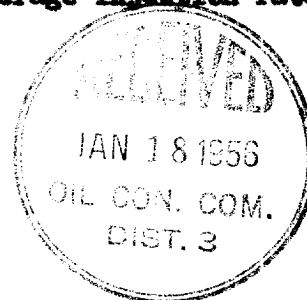

Total Depth 4900'. Cleanout depth 4860'.

Sandoil fractured Basal Gallup section. Treated intervals 4786-4822 and 4829-4854 (through perforations in liner, 4 holes per foot) with 56,860 gallons No. 2 diesel oil and 60,000# regular sand. Breakdown pressure 3400 psi, maximum treating pressure 2300 psi, average treating pressure 1700 psi. Average injection rate 38.4 bbls./min. Flushed with 6600 gallons of water.
