DETAILS OF WORK

Conversion Work

1. Pressure tested tubing with 1000 psi. for 15 minutes, Ok.
2. Swabbed while running clean Point Lookout water (treated with Triton X-100 detergent) down casing. After tubing became clean, pulled. Bailed clean.
3. Ran tubing with packer
4. Pumped 60 bbls. of inhibited water down annulus to displace uninhibited fluid. Set packer at 4814', and filled with inhibited water. Will notify when injection starts.

I understand that this plan of work must receive approval in writing by the Geological Survey before operations may be commenced.
