

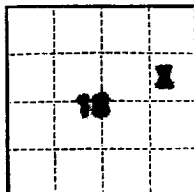

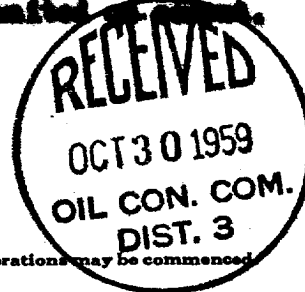

Tested BOP and casing with 700 psi, OK.
