Your #1 Weaver well in E-15-25N 11W, Bisti Lower Gallup Pool, was assigned an initial allowable effective September 29, 1959. Oil Conservation Commission rules require that a gas oil ratio test be conducted between 30 and 60 days after completion and submitted to this office not later than 10 days thereafter.

We have not received a gas-oil ratio test on this well as of this date and for that reason have not given the well a December allowable. Will you please submit this test immediately in order to avoid further loss of allowable.
