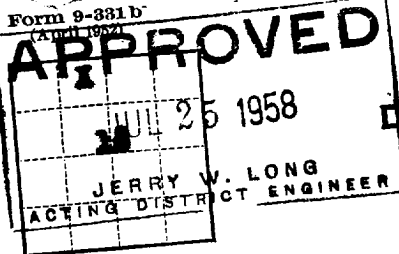

DETAILS OF WORK

Proposed Work:

1. Drill 12 1/4" hole to 100'±.
2. Cement 8 5/8" casing at 100'± with 50 sacks treated cement.
3. Drill 7 7/8" hole to 5050'±.
4. Cement 4 1/2" casing at 5045'± with 150 sacks regular cement.
5. Perforate four 1/2" holes/ft. in intervals determined by logs.
6. Sand-oil fracture with 50,000 gal. crude oil and 1#/gal. 20-40 mesh sand.
7. Hang 2 3/8" tubing at top of perforations.
8. Swab well into production and establish rate.

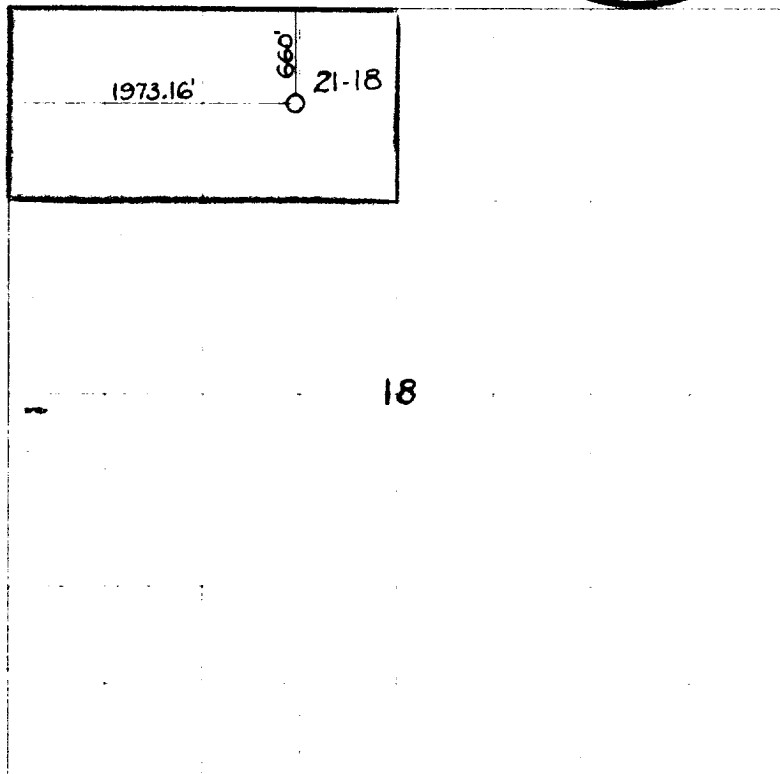
