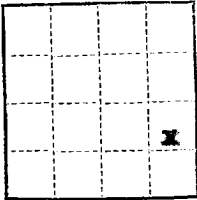

DETAILS OF WORK

This well was spudded 8-7-56. A 12 1/4" hole was drilled to 360'. A 5/8" casing was set at 346' with 225 sacks cement. Cement circulated. After 24 hours MOC time casing was tested to 750' for 3 minutes.

A 7 7/8" hole was drilled to 5020'. 5 1/2" casing was set at 4990' with 200 sacks cement. Top cement in annulus is at 3925' by temperature survey. After 41 hours MOC time, casing was tested to 1500' for 30 minutes.

I understand that this plan of work must receive approval in writing by the Geological Survey before operations may be commenced.
