DETAILS OF WORK

We propose to locate the E. P. Campbell well
 Lucille H. Pickett, drill out cement plugs, and run
 it 1500' total depth, 11" casing up to 500' and 8"
 and sandstone to bottom 1400' - 1420' and sandstone
 plug and cement and sandstone to bottom 1400' - 1420'
 and sandstone is cemented in place to shut off these
 zones. If completion attempt is a failure we prepare to
 abandon, set cement plugs and return the hole and location to condition.

I understand that this plan of work must receive approval in writing by the Geological Survey before operations may be commenced.
