DETAILS OF WORK

Ka-Da-Pah Well No. 2 was perforated with four shots per foot 4816-48, 4820-90, 4896-4910. Sand-oil fracked with 50,000 gallons oil and 50,000 pounds sand. Formation broke at 2650 pounds. Average injection rate 24 BPM. Injected 125 rubber balls during frac for selective treatment. A pumping unit has been installed on Ka-Da-Pah well no. 2 and well is still being tested to recover free oil.
