- 6-16-51 Run and cemented (new) 4-1/2", 7.61, J-50 casing at 4000' with 100 sacks 22 cu. ft., Portland cement treated with 4% gel. Surface temperature 60°F, formation temperature 120°F. (Estimated strength after 12 hrs. 1500 psi). Replaced with oil. Total 1000 psi, 1%.
- 6-17-51 Perforated four 1/2" holes/ft. 4000-4000.
- 6-18-51 Cotted 200 gal. mud acid on perforations.
- 6-20-51 Well tested - swabbed up, in 6 hrs. recovered 65 bbls. oil (70 bbls. total oil in hole.)
- 6-21-51 Run oil fractured with 25,000 gal. crude, 14/gal. sand. Maximum pressure 3000 psi, average rate 20 bbls./min.
- 6-22-51 Bailed 6' of frac sand. Run tubing to 4000'. Run pump and rods.
