Gentlemen:

Enclosed is your Application for Permit to Drill (APD) well No. 31 Federal 17, NW/4SW/4 sec. 17, T. 25 N., R. 8 W., San Juan County, New Mexico, lease NM-61561. As discussed with Mr. Peter Gowan of your company on June 6, 1991, the subject APD is rescinded and returned due to drilling not being commenced within one year of the approval date.
