

Gentlemen:

Pro New Mexico has just discovered that Giant Exploration & Production Company has obtained a permit to drill a Basin Dakota well in the NE/4, Section 24, T25N, R11W, San Juan County, New Mexico. The application was designated by Giant as "confidential".

Our company holds oil and gas leases on the W/2 and St/4 of that Section 24. Ostensibly Giant is attempting to include our leasehold in the SE/4 as part of the necessary 320 acres for dedication to the proposed Dakora well. This action has been taken without any effort to communitize the E/2 of Section 24; indeed, without even notifying Pro New Mexico.

Your filing with the NMOCD and BLM intentionally inisreplesents that Giant controls the proration unit acreage on the dedication plat and lais to conform to the requirements of Rule 1102 of the Oil Conservation Commission and violates the instructions on the Form C-102.
