Gentlemen:

E. L. Fundingsland is the operator of the No. D-2 Sunical-Federal well, located in the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. 19, T. 26 N., R. 7 W., Rio Arriba County, New Mexico, on Federal oil and gas lease New Mexico 011639. Said well was last produced in June 1969 and was disconnected from El Paso Natural Gas Company's sales line on August 22, 1970.

Temporary abandonment of any well under jurisdiction of the U.S. Geological Survey must now receive formal approval. Such approval may be granted, for a period not to exceed one year, provided reasons for temporary abandonment are deemed adequate.

Please submit an original and four copies of Sundry Notice (form 9-331) requesting temporary abandonment for the above well. This request should set forth the present status, date of last production, reason for requesting temporary abandonment, and future plans for the well including approximate dates of planned workovers or plugging operations.
