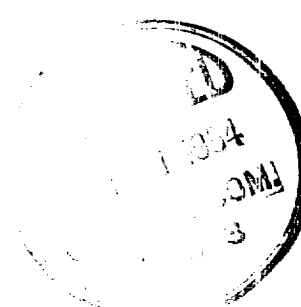

DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

The well was drilled with 13 3/4" rotary hole to 110 feet, 106 feet of 10 3/4", 32.75# surface casing was set and circulated out with 65 sacks of regular cement. Went in with drill pipe and drilled cement to shoe, closed rams on B.O.P. and pressured up to 500# and held with no loss in pressure for 30 minutes.
