

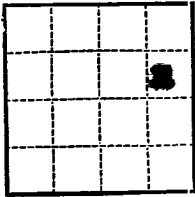

If commercial production is indicated, the producing section is oil and gas and is fractured.

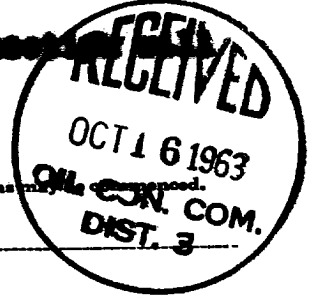
