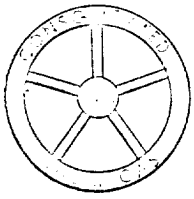

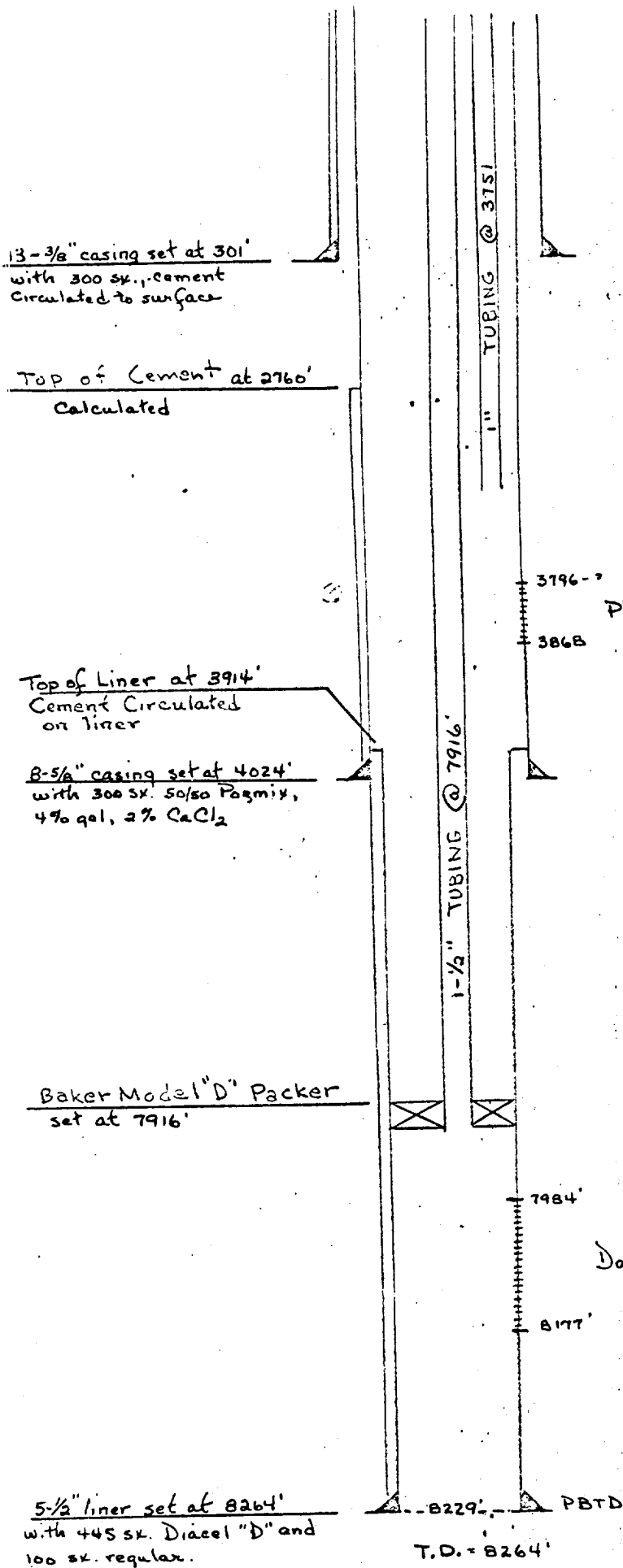
Location Map to Accompany Application for Dual Completion
