

THE APPLICATION OF CONSOLIDATED OIL
& GAS, INC. FOR A DUAL COMPLETION.

ORDER NO. MC-1275

ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER
OF THE OIL CONSERVATION COMMISSION

Under the provisions of Rule 112-A, Consolidated Oil & Gas, Inc. made application to the New Mexico Oil Conservation Commission on January 9, 1963, for permission to dually complete its Champlin Well No. 2-35 located in Unit J of Section 35, Township 27 North, Range 4 West, NMPM, Rio Arriba County, New Mexico, in such a manner as to produce gas from the Pictured Cliffs formation adjacent to the Tapacito-Pictured Cliffs Pool and the Blanco-Mesaverde Pool.

Now, on this 15th day of January, 1963, the Secretary-Director finds:

- (1) That application has been duly filed under the provisions of Rule 112-A of the Commission's Rules and Regulations;
- (2) That satisfactory information has been provided that all operators of offset acreage have been duly notified; and
- (3) That waivers of objection have been received from offset operators and the waiting period as prescribed by said rule may be dispensed with at this time.
- (4) That the proposed dual completion will not cause waste nor impair correlative rights.
- (5) That the mechanics of the proposed dual completion are feasible and consonant with good conservation practices.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

That the applicant herein, Consolidated Oil & Gas, Inc., be and the same is hereby authorized to dually complete its Champlin Well No. 2-35 located in Unit J of Section 35, Township 27 North, Range 4 West, NMPM, Rio Arriba County, New Mexico, in such a manner as to produce gas from the Pictured Cliffs Formation adjacent to the Tapacito-Pictured Cliffs Pool and the Blanco-Mesaverde Pool, through parallel strings of tubing.

PROVIDED HOWEVER, That applicant shall complete, operate, and produce said well in accordance with the provisions of Rule 112-A.

PROVIDED FURTHER, That applicant shall take packer-leakage tests upon completion and annually thereafter during the Annual Deliverability Test Period for the Blanco-Mesaverde Pool.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED: That jurisdiction of this cause is hereby retained for the entry of such further orders as the Commission may deem necessary.
