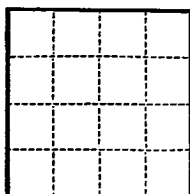

DETAILS OF WORK

On November 19, 1962, this well was plugged and abandoned as follows:

1. Spotted a 100 sack cement plug from 4750' to 6156'.
2. Shot 7" casing @ 1833'. Spotted a 25 sack cement plug from 1833-1725'.
3. Pulled 7" casing and spotted a 20 sack cement plug in surface with a 4' x 4" dry hole marker.
