This is to request your approval of a dual Pictured Cliffs - Mesa Verde well we propose to drill in the NE_{\pm}^{1} of Section 35-27N-6W, Rio Arriba County, New Mexico. This well will be a diagonal southwest offset to the El Paso Natural Gas Company San Juan Unit 28-6 #70, SW $_{\pm}^{1}$ Section 25-27N-6W, which is a dual Pictured Cliffs - Mesa Verde producer.

We propose to set approximately 120' of 10-3/4" surface casing, approximately 3500' of 7-5/8" casing through the Pictured Cliffs Sand, then gas drill to approximately 5700' and cement a $5\frac{1}{2}$ " liner from 3450' to 5700'. The Point Lookout, Cliff House and Pictured Cliffs Sands will be perforated and water frac'd separately after which 2" tubing will be run to approximately 5600' with a Baker Model EGJ Packer set in the $5\frac{1}{2}$ " liner at approximately 3600'. After landing the 2" tubing, a parallel string of $1\frac{1}{4}$ " EUE tubing will be run to about 3400'.
