Reference is made to your application requesting authorization to down hole commingle gas and associated liquid hydrocarbons from the Pictured Cliffs and Mesaverde formations in the above referenced well. After reviewing your application and the well completion information you supplied, we concur with using the following fixed allocation factors:

<u>Formation</u>	<u>Gas</u>	<u>Oil</u>
Mesaverde	68%	50%
Pictured Cliffs	32%	50%

Commingled production from each zone must be reported in accordance with these established allocation factors. The effective date of commingling will be the date commingling first occurs.
