PROVIDED HOWEVER, That applicant shall complete, operate, and produce said well in accordance with the provisions of Rule 112-A.

PROVIDED FURTHER, That applicant shall take packer-leakage tests upon completion and annually thereafter during the Annual Deliverability Test Period for the Blanco-Mesaverde Pool.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED: That jurisdiction of this cause is hereby retained for the entry of such further orders as the Commission may deem necessary.

PROVIDED FURTHER, That applicant shall take proper precautions to prevent completion and operating the well during the winter season, and shall keep the well open for the Rio Grande-Stevens Oilfield.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, That termination of this order is hereby retained for the entry of such further orders as the Commission may deem necessary.

PROVIDED HOWEVER, that applicant shall complete, operate and produce said well in accordance with the provisions of Rule 113-A.

PROVIDED FURTHER, that applicant shall take proper steps to prevent any completion and naturally thereafter during the waiting period for the Blanco-Massey pool.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED: That jurisdiction of this case is hereby retained for the entry of such further orders as the Commission may deem necessary.
