DETAILS OF WORK

It is intended to mud drill a well with rotary tools thru the Dakota formation, and to perforate and fracture possible producing zones. Est. T. D. 7709'.

Casing Program:

- 9 5/8" @ 300' w/200 sks. cement circulated to surface.
- 4 1/2" @ 7709' w/two & three stage collars. Set 2nd stage collar 50' - 100' below base of Mesa Verde, 3rd stage 50' - 100' below base of Pictured Cliffs.
- Cement first stage w/130 sks. to cover 200' above Greenhorn
- Second stage w/210 sks. to cover 100' above Cliff House
- Third stage w/210 sks. to cover Ojo Alamo.

The N/2 of Section 22 is dedicated to this well.
