Following is a Notice of Intention to do certain work as described below at the San Juan 27-4 Unit
El Paso Natural Gas Company Well No. 14 (MD) in L
(Company or Operator) East Campanero Dakota Extension
NW SW 18 T. 27N R. 4W NMPM, Blanco Mesa Verde Pool
(40-acre Subdivision) 1/4 of Sec. 18, T. 27N R. 4W NMPM, Blanco Mesa Verde Pool
Rio Arriba County.

FULL DETAILS OF PROPOSED PLAN OF WORK
(FOLLOW INSTRUCTIONS IN THE RULES AND REGULATIONS)

Total depth of original hole 8008'. Original hole contains 1423' of dropped 5 1/2" casing and is squeezed off with 1075 sacks cement. Two subsequent attempts were made to drill directional holes, failed, and were plugged with 550 and 1200 sacks of cement, respectively. Whipstock was set at 4086 and directional hole drilled to 6427', at which point water flow came in through hole in 9 5/8" casing at 3034-3039'. Water was shut off with 530 sack cement squeeze. The 9 5/8" casing is now partially collapsed at 3151-3154, with an 8 3/4" bit lost on bottom of directional hole at 6427'. Three attempts to recover the bit have failed. It is therefore intended to plug and abandon this well as follows:

1. Set cast iron retainer in 9 5/8" casing at approximately 2950', and set 100 foot plug at bottom of casing from 3640 to 3540 with 40 sacks cement.
2. Set cement plug from 100' back to surface with 40 sacks.
3. Set 4' x 4" pipe at surface as permanent marker.
