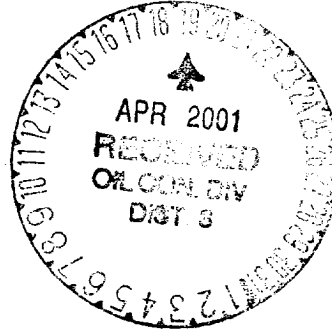

Dear Ms. Cole:

We have received your allocation factors and your Application for Downhole Commingling of the Mesaverde and Dakota formations in the above listed well. In two letters we have received dated 8-15-98 and 11-10-00 the gas allocation factors are unacceptable because both 7% and 1% for the Dakota are below the historical decline for this well.
