This marginal well, 13 MCF/D, developed a casing leak and its low production rate did not justify a repair workover. Hence, the San Juan 27-4 Unit #72 well was plugged and abandoned on June 29, 1984.

6-28-84: Killed well with 100 barrels of water; installed BOP's; Spotted 22 sacks (26 cf.) of cement through 1 1/4" tubing at 4090'. This plug covers the Pictured Cliffs perms and the Ojo Alamo with its top at 3470'.

6-29-84: Tagged cement with the tubing at 3324'; TOH with the tubing and laid it down; perforated 4 squeeze holes at 176'; established circulation out the bradenhead; pumped 40 sacks (47 cf.) of cement for surface plug; cut off well head; cemented dry hole marker with 5 sacks. Job complete 2:30 p.m.
