Details regarding existing roads, pipelines, wells, etc. relative to the above well location are included on the previously submitted base maps, "Field Road Map" and "Composite Map No. 1".

The proposed new well location and new roads are shown on the attached plat along with connecting existing roads and pipelines in the vicinity of the proposed new well. The new pipelines are not shown since they have not yet been approved by the Forest Service.

Water for drilling and completion operations will be obtained from the following location: a water hole located in the SE/4 Section 18, T-27-N, R-4-W.

Upon completion or abandonment of this well, the location will be cleaned and leveled and a dry hole marker placed, if applicable.
