This well was shut-in and disconnected by the recent former owner, Nassau Resources. Conoco, who recently acquired ownership of this well in a property purchase from Nassau, is in the process of evaluating and working-over the wells on these properties in an attempt to maximize their gas recovery.

It appears that this well was not properly unloaded following its completion by Nassau and was shut-in. An attempt will be made to return this well to producing status by swabbing the well to determine if commercial rates can be established.

It is anticipated that well work required to evaluate its commercial status will be completed by July 1, 1995.
