THE APPLICATION OF EL PASO NATURAL GAS COMPANY FOR A DUAL COMPLETION

ORDER NO. MC-2907

ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER OF THE OIL CONSERVATION DIVISION

Under the provisions of Rule 112-A El Paso Natural Gas Company made application to the New Mexico Oil Conservation Division on August 6, 1981, for permission to dually complete its San Juan 27-5 Unit Well No. 101-E located in Unit O of Section 10, Township 27 North, Range 5 West, NMPM, Rio Arriba County, New Mexico, in such a manner as to permit production of gas from the Blanco-Mesaverde Pool and from the Basin-Dakota Pool.

NOW, on this 7th of August, 1981, the Division Director finds:

- 1. That application has been filed under the provisions of Rule 112-A of the Division's Rules and Regulations;
- 2. That satisfactory information has been provided that there are no other operators of offset acreage.
- 3. That the proposed dual completion will not cause waste nor impair correlative rights; and
- 4. That the mechanics of the proposed dual completion are feasible and consonant with good conservation practices.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

That the applicant herein, El Paso Natural Gas Company be and the same is hereby authorized to dually complete its San Juan 27-5 Unit Well No. 101-E located in Unit O of Section 10, Township 27 North, Range 5 West, NMPM, Rio Arriba County, New Mexico, in such a manner as to permit production of gas from the Blanco-Mesaverde Pool and from the Baskin-Dakota Pool through parallel strings of tubing.

PROVIDED HOWEVER, That applicant shall complete, operate, and produce said well in accordance with the provisions of Rule 112-A.

PROVIDED FURTHER, That applicant shall take packer-leakage tests upon completion and annually thereafter.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED: That jurisdiction of this cause is hereby retained for the entry of such further orders as the Division may deem necessary.
