
Dear Mr. Wood:

Reference is made to your application dated February 25, 1995 on behalf of the operator EnRe Corporation for a non-standard Blanco-Mesaverde gas well location for the existing **Leavry Canyon 24-N Well No. 1** (API No. 30-039-25229) which was drilled in 1992 to test the West Puerto Chiquito Mancos Oil Pool at a previously approved unorthodox oil well location (Division Order No. R-9720, dated September 11, 1992) 1025 feet from the South line and 2030 feet from the West line (**Unit N**) of **Section 24, Township 27 North, Range 2 West, NMPM, Rio Arriba County, New Mexico.**

It is my understanding that the well will be recompleted to the Blanco-Mesaverde Pool, which pursuant to the Special Rules and Regulations for the Pool as promulgated by Division Order No. R-8170, as amended, is unorthodox. Further, the S/2 of said Section 24 shall be dedicated to the well forming a standard 320-acre gas spacing and proration unit for said pool.

By the authority granted me under the provisions of Rule 2(c) of said special pool rules, the above-described unorthodox gas well location is hereby approved.
