Dear Mr. Benson:

It has been determined subsequent to our initial evaluation of your application dated November 13, 1995 that the provisions of Rule 2(c) of the "General Rules For The Prorated Gas Pools of New Mexico/Special Rules and Regulations For The Basin-Dakota Pool/Special Rules and Regulations For The Blanco-Mesaverde Pool/Special Rules and Regulations For The South Blanco-Pictured Cliffs Pool", as promulgated by Division Order No. R-8170, as amended, does not permit the Division to process the subject application administratively since the intent of this unorthodox location is for geologic reasons and not topographic, as stated in part 12 of OCD Form C-103, dated May 30, 1995 (see copy attached).

This application will be placed on the next available Examiners Hearing docket scheduled for December 21, 1995. Further, you as applicant must provide adequate notice of this matter pursuant to all applicable provisions of Division General Rule 1207.A(5).

## 12. Proposed or Completed Operations:

Rincon Unit #131E was originally staked @ 1145' FNL & 1525' FWL, Section 36, T27N-R7W, Rio Arriba Co., NM, and permitted (State APD approved 4-6-94, APD extension and casing design change approved 1-31-95) as a Basin Dakota/Blanco Mesaverde well.

Unocal requests approval to move the existing Rincon Unit 131E location to 1985' FNL, 822' FWL, Sec. 36, T27N-R7W and complete as a Basin Dakota/Blanco Mesaverde/South Blanco Pictured Cliffs well. Unocal wishes to move the location to take advantage of more favorable sub-surface geological structures; i.e. incorporate the Pictured Cliffs formation into the overall completion of the well. There is only one existing Pictured Cliffs well in the same 1/4 section (Rincon #10), and it is presently shut in and scheduled for P&A later this year.

Unocal also requests approval of a non-standard location for the proposed Rincon Unit 131E. The proposed location does not conform to a standard (Dak./M.V./P.C.) location being approximately 135' too far South. The proposed location cannot be moved to the North due to an existing El Paso Natural Gas lateral line and an existing Arroyo (see attached Pad Layout and topography). Unocal is the sole off-set lease cwner/operator.

There will be no changes to the existing approved Drilling/ Completion plan (approved Jan 31, 1995.)
