APRINISTRATIVE ORDER OF THE OIL COMMERVATION COMMISSION

Under the provisions of Rule 112-A Caulkins Oil Company made application to the New Mexico Oil Conservation Commission on June 29, 1965, for permission to dually complete its Breech "F" Well No. (ND)-45 located in Unit M of Section 35, Tewnship 27 North, Range 6 West, MNPM, Rio Arriba County, New Mexico, in such a manner as to produce gas from the Blanco-Mesaverde Pool and the Basin-Daketa Pool.

Now, on this 19th day of July, 1965, the Secretary-Director finds:

- (1) That application has been duly filed under the previsions of Rule 112-A of the Commission's Rules and Regulations;
- (2) That satisfactory information has been provided that all operators of offset acreage have been duly notified; and
- (3) That no objections have been received within the waiting period as prescribed by said rule.
- (4) That the proposed dual completion will not cause waste nor impair correlative rights.
- (5) That the mechanics of the proposed dual completion are feasible and consenant with good conservation practices.

IT IS THEREFORE CRASSED!

That the applicant herein, Caulkins Oil Company, be and the same is hereby authorized to dually complete its Breech "F" Well No. MD-45 located in Unit N of Section 35, Township 27 North, Range 6 West, MMMM, Rie Arriba County, New Mexico, in such a manner as to produce gas from the Blanco-Mesaverde Pool and the Basin-Dakota Pool through parallel strings of tubing.

province moving. That applicant shall complete, operate, and produce said well in accordance with the provisions of Rule 112-A.

PROVIDED PROTECT. That applicant shall take packerleakage tests upon completion and annually thereafter during the Annual Deliverability Test Period for the Basin-Dakota Pool.

IT IS FURTHER COMMEND: That jurisdiction of this cause is hereby retained for the entry of such further orders as the Commission may does necessary.
