## ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER OF THE OIL CONSERVATION COMMISSION

Under the provisions of Rule 112-A El Paso Natural Gas Company made application to the New Mexico Oil Genservation Commission on March 8, 1963 for permission to dually complete its San Juan 27-5 Unit Vell No. 71 located in Unit A of Section 28, Township 27 North, Range 5 West, NEWH, Rio Arriba County, New Mexico, in such a manner as to permit the production of Gas from the Tapacito-Fictured Cliffs Pool and the Blanco-Mesaverde Pool.

Now, on this 14th day of March, 1963, the Secretary-Director finds:

- (1) That application has been duly filed under the provisions of Rule 112-A of the Commission's Rules and Regulations;
- (2) That satisfactory information has been provided that all operators of offset acreage have been duly notified; and
- (3) That no objections have been received within the waiting period as prescribed by said rule.
- (4) That the proposed dual completion will not cause waste nor impair correlative rights.
- (5) That the mechanics of the proposed dual completion are feasible and consonant with good conservation practices.

## IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

That the applicant herein, El Paso Natural Gas Company, be and the same is hereby authorized to dually complete its San Juan 27-5 Unit Well No. 71 located in Unit A of Section 28, Township 27 North, Range 5 West, MMPM, Rio Arriba County, New Mexico, in such a manner as to permit the production of Gas from the Tapacito-Pictured Cliffs Pool and the Blanco-Mesaverde Pool through parallel strings of tubing.

PROVIDED BOWKVER, That applicant shall complete, operate, and produce said well in accordance with the provisions of Rule 112-A.

PROVIDED FUTTHER, That applicant shall take packer-leakage tests upon completion and annually thereafter during the Annual Deliverability Test Feriod for the Blanco-Messverde Pool.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED: That jurisdication of this cause is hereby retained for the entry of such further orders as the Commission may deem necessary.
