NORTHWEST NEW MEXICO PACKER LEAKAGE TEST INSTRUCTIONS

- 1. A poster lealings test shall be communicated on each multiply completed well within seven days after accust overplation of the well, and assembly thesenfor as prescribed by the order authorizing the multiple completions within seven days following recomplation smaller channical or fine-test steament, and whenever committed work has been accused one on a well during which the poster or the taking have been disturbed. Tosts shall also be taken at any time that communication is suspected or when required by the Division.
- any time that communication is suspended or when requested by the Division.

 2. At least 72 hours prior to the communicated of any protor lealings test, the operator shall notify the Division in writing of the const time the test is to be communed. Offset operator shall also be so notified.
- 3. The proton imings test shall commence when both source of the dual completion are shad in for processes stabilization. both mone shall stemmin shad-in until the weil-head presence in each lass stabilized, provided however, that they need not seemin shad-in more than seven days.
- 4. For flow Test No. 1, one zone of the dual completion shall be produced at the mormal rate of production while the other zone seemine shall as. Such test shall be continued for seven days of the case of a pa well and for 24 hours in the case of an oil well. Note: if, on an initial packer lealings test, a pas well is being flowed to the namosphese due to the lock of a pipeline connection the flow period shall be three hours.
- 5. Following completion of flow Test No. 1, the well shall again be shut-in, in accordance with Paragraph 3 above.
- 6. Flow Test No. 2 shall be constanted even though no lenk was indicated during flow Test No. 1.

 Proceedure for Flow Test No. 2 is to be the same as for Flow Test No. 1

- except that the proviously produced zone shall remain shat-in while the zone which was proviously shat-in is produced.
- 7. Pressures for gas-nose tests must be measured on each zone with a deadweight pressure gauge at time intervals as follows: 3 hours tests: immediately prior to the beginning of each flow-period, at fifteen minute intervals during the first hour thouser, and at hously intervals thousenfar, including one pressures measurement immediately prior to the flow period, at least one time during each flow period (at approximately the midway point) and immediately prior to the conclusion of each flow period. Other pressures may be taken as desired, or may be requested on wells which have proviously shown questionable test date.
- 24-hour oil must tester all pressures, throughout the entire test, shall be continuously measured and seconded with recording pressure gauges the accuracy of which must be checked at least twice, once at the beginning and once at the end of onch test, with a dondrought pressure gauge, if a well is a gas-oil or an ell-yes shall completion, the recording gauge shall be required on the oil zone enly, with deadwaying pressures as required shows being taken on the gaz zone.
- 8. The sessues of the above described note shall be filed in triplicate within 1.5 days after completion of the test. Tests shall be filed with the Aster District Office of the New Mexico Oil Conservation Division of Northwest New Mexico Pachare Lealange Test form Revised 10/01/78 with all deadweight presentes indicated themen as well as the flowing temperatures (gas notes only) and gravity and GOR (oil notes only).
