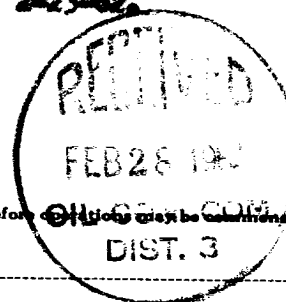

2-23-62 Palledreds and tubing. Rigged up Western Company, filled hole and broke down with 145 barrels oil, 1600 psi at 22.5 BPM. Treated with 20,000 lb. 20-40 sand in 20,000 gal. oil, 1080 lb. Versene Acid and 1000 lb. Citric Acid mixed during entire treatment. Treated at 1500 psi at 22.5 BPM. Flushed with 135 barrels oil, 1500 psi at rate of 22.6 BPM. Instant shut in pressure 1200 psi, 15 minute shut in pressure 1000 psi, on vacuum in 3 hours. Job Complete 11:30 A.M. 2-23-62.
