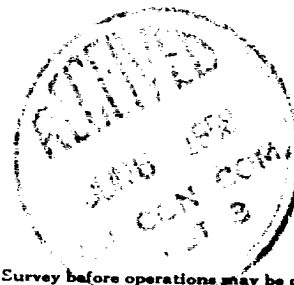

placed to 5480' TD. Ran temperature survey, found top of cement at 4700' TD.
