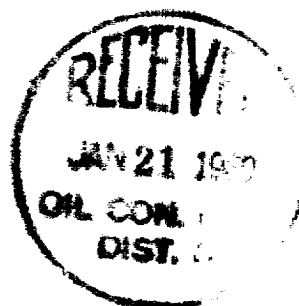
Subject: Exception from No-Flare Order No. R-1427
Tennessee Gas Transmission Company
(USA) W. O. Berger No. 1, Unit B,
Section 21, T26N, R11W

We request that the two subject wells be granted a 90 day exception to Order No. R-1427 prohibiting the flaring of casinghead gas. Tennessee Gas Transmission executed a casinghead gas contract dated February 4, 1959, which committed the casinghead gas from the two subject wells to El Paso Natural Gas Company. We contacted El Paso Natural Gas Company in Farmington, New Mexico, and were informed by El Paso that they do not plan to connect these wells to their casinghead gas collection system. Their representative stated it was not economically feasible at the present time to extend the casinghead gas collection system to our (USA) W. O. Berger lease. However, they were negotiating with other operators for additional gas and anticipated that the casinghead gas collection system would be extended to Tennessee's (USA) W. O. Berger lease within the near future.

We believe that Tennessee Gas Transmission Company has diligently made every effort to make beneficial use of the casinghead gas from the subject wells, but is unable to do so because of a situation over which it has no control.

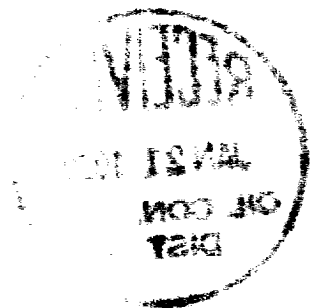
