Gentlemen:

We are in receipt of a copy of the Notice of Intention to Drill on Southern Union Gas Company's #4 Nickson, located 490 feet from the South line and 1890 feet from the West line of Section 14-26N-8W. It is noted on the face of the form that this is a re-submittal of Notice of Intention to Drill formerly filed June 23, 1955.

On checking our files we find that we do have a copy of the original Notice with the surveyor's plat. However, you will note that this is an unorthodox location and therefore administrative approval of the non-standard location must be secured from Mr. A. L. Porter, Secretary-Director of the Commission.

Form C-128 as refised 5-1-57 should also be submitted in triplicate indicating the acreage to be dedicated to this well and information concerning communitization. It will be necessary that the above matters be taken care of before an allowable is granted this well. If we can be of any service in the matter, please let us know.
