Kill well. Pull rods & tubing. Trip into hole to check for junk. If clean, will squeeze the Pennsylvanian perforations from 6216-26' and 6234-43'. Pressure test casing.

Clean out to 6910±. Run CB and TDT Logs for intervals 6900 to 6400' and 4400 to 4300'.

If conditions look favorable, will test Mississippian Interval 6400 to 6900' and/or Organ Rock interval from 4300 to 4400'.

If conditions do not look favorable, we will contact BLM for further plugging instructions.

A small earthen, fenced pit will be needed on the location during this overall operation. Pit will be filled and levelled when conditions allow.
