one year exception to such no-flare order.

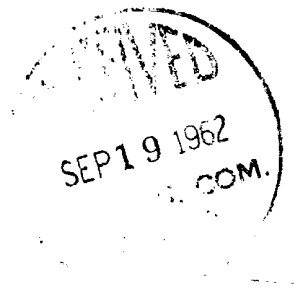

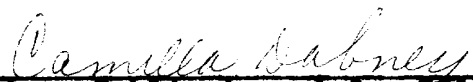
That said well continues to operate under said exception to the no-flare order;

APPLICATION FOR EXTENSION OF EXCEPTION

to

NO-FLARE ORDER

in re: APPLICATION OF ROCANVILLE CORPORATION for
EXTENSION OF AN EXCEPTION TO NO-FLARE
ORDER NO. 474, COVERING THE NO. 1 RIDDLE
TRUST WELL LOCATED IN SECTION 18, TOWNSHIP
23 NORTH, RANGE 13 WEST, N.M.P.M.

Comes now the applicant and states:

1. That heretofore on the 17th day of February, 1960, this Commission issued an exception to no-flare order No. 474, and on July 1, 1960, and again on January 10, 1961, and in October of 1961, extended such exception, lastly to the 20th day of October, 1962.

2. That the same conditions exist now which existed at the last extension of the above referred to exception to no-flare order No. 474, all of which is affirmed in the affidavit marked exhibit "A" and attached hereto, and it still remains uneconomical to produce the gas produced incidental to oil production on the above described well into a pipeline, no pipeline company being willing to make a pipeline connection to such well and to collect casinghead gas produced incidental to oil production therefrom.

3. Applicant is entitled to a further order of this Commission granting the extension of the exception hereto granted to no-flare order 474, and extending its permission to flare gas from the above described well for another period of one year from October 20, 1962.

WHEREFORE, applicant prays that this Commission issue an Administrative Order extending the exception to no-flare order No. 474 from October 20, 1962 to October 20, 1963.

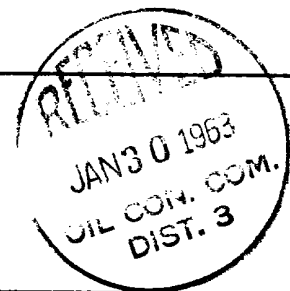
