Reference is made to your letter of April 20, 1959 regarding production information for lands surrounding New Mexico State Lease E-2525. The yearly statistical report on production which is compiled by the Commission has not yet been published, so it would be very difficult to give you the information requested at the present time. At such time as this information is available we will be glad to furnish it to you.

I have checked our records on the Southern Union Ruthven well and find that it is a marginal well with a deliverability of 92 MCF per day. This means that it should be allowed to produce whatever amount of gas it is able to deliver into the pipeline. All wells in the area are prorated under the same formula and takes of gas from all wells in the area should therefore be ratable.

This means that it would be allowed to produce whatever amount of gas it is able to deliver into the pipeline. All wells in the area are produced under the same formula and basis of gas from all wells in the area should therefore be similar.


